## BOOMERANG PARK BARBEQUE

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### RECOMMENDATION IS THAT COUNCIL:

- 1) Proceed with the installation of a barbeque, shelter and services at Boomerang Park playground.

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### BACKGROUND

The purpose of this report is to provide additional information of the proposed barbeque, shelter and services at Boomerang Park.

### ISSUES

The barbeque will be located adjacent to existing picnic facilities near the playground and public toilet. The barbeque will be specified as a stainless steel twin-plate model that is wheelchair accessible.

The shelter will be designed and constructed of timber and Colorbond steel to match existing shelters. Water and electricity will be connected to existing services at the public toilet. The existing bin cabinets will be relocated to accommodate the new barbeque.

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### RECOMMENDATION IS THAT COUNCIL:

- 1) Resolve to create a cash reserve dedicated to the operation and renewal of Council's Community Halls.

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### BACKGROUND

The purpose of this report is to provide Councillors with updated information relating to the use of the Community Halls Reserve.

Income received from hiring of community halls will be used to maintain operations at each of the halls managed by Council. Any funds remaining at the end of each financial year will be transferred into the Community Halls Reserve.

Initial funding will be received into this reserve at the end of the current financial year, ie. 1 July 2023.

Funds will remain in this reserve until sufficient resources are available to undertake:

- Minor improvements following feedback from volunteer groups.
- Major improvements identified in the asset management plan for community halls.

Expenditure of funds will be determined on community requirement and Council's responsibility for ensuring facilities are fit for purpose.
