The future vision for Raymond Terrace is outlined in the draft Public Domain Plan (PDP) – a 20 year vision for how we can revitalise the town centre and create improved public spaces for our community.

There are 3 big moves planned for Raymond Terrace:

Healthy Streets



Streets prioritise people and are safe, walkable, comfortable, and well connected. Focus is on shade, street tree planting, street lighting, improved footpath links and extended cycle pathways.

Improved look and feel of streets and creation of spaces for events, public art and gatherings. This includes pocket parks, river walkway and lookout, interesting street seating and artwork.

Unique Experiences


